Notes Mail – new capabilities

- Set a default font for mail
- Sort Inbox
 - By type of message (email, calendar, to do)
 - By Last name, First name
- Forward a message from the Trash folder
 - No need to restore first
- Save emails as .eml files
- More signature options
 - Can now use rich text in addition to plain text and HTML/image



Display names in mail in this format:

Note: This feature is only supported if you're accessing your mail on a Notes 8.52 server (or higher) or using a local mail replica.

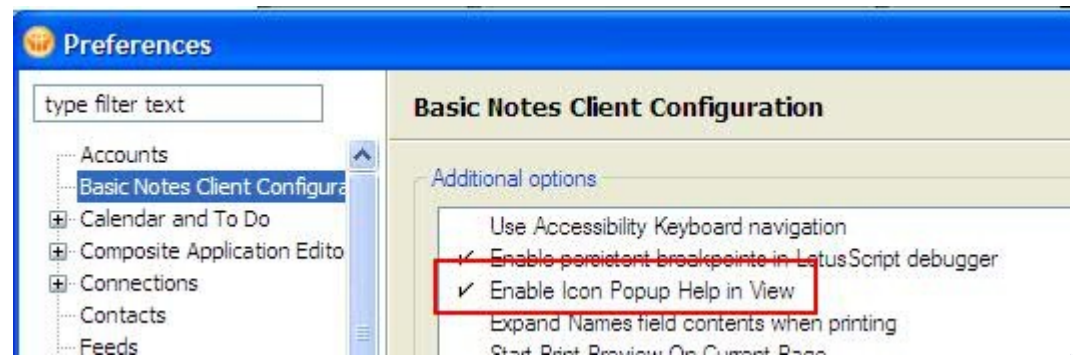


Notes Mail – more preferences

- Show details in an email
- Always get a return receipt
- Close an email after forwarding or replying to it



- Start with preview pane collapsed
- Hide icon pop-up help (works in all Mail, Calendar and Contacts)

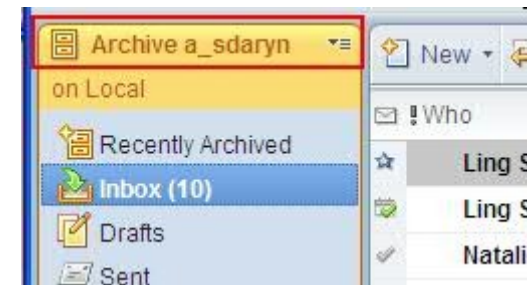


Notes Mail – usability improvements

- Retain folder status (open/closed) when restart Notes client
- Easier to find groups when addressing an email



- Easier to tell which archive you have open



- F4 and Shift+F4 function usage
 - Click F4 to move to the next unread message.
 - Click Shift+F4 to move to the previous unread message
- “HTML Size” MIME setting fixed at 12
 - Ensures mapping is consistent as text is converted between email format

- View teamroom calendars on a mobile device
- Add private iCal feeds to your Notes calendars
- View rooms and resources on your calendar
- View calendar entries by category

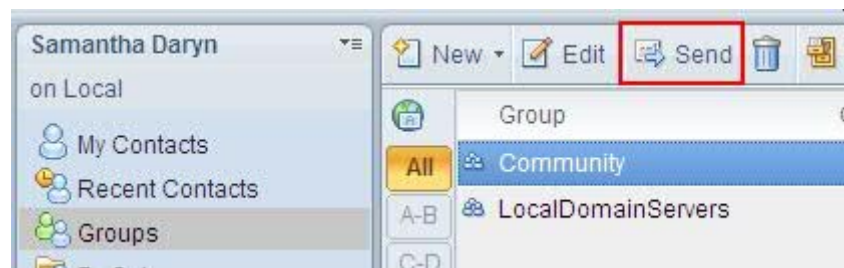
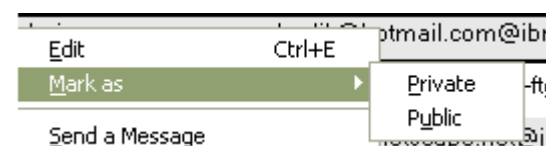
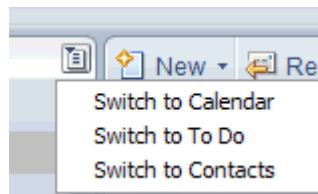
Notes Calendar – Usability Improvements

- Retain calendar pane status (open/closed) when restart Notes client
- Better handling of Facebook calendar entries
- Calendar times change to match OS timezone
- Meeting subject changes are reflected in Rooms and Resource reservations
- Offline calendars automatically update at midnight
- Different options when repeating meeting falls on a “weekend”
 - Uses “Days in work week” preference (weekend is no longer assumed to be Saturday and Sunday)



Notes Contacts

- Switch to Contacts
- Make a contact or group private
- Send someone a group or location document



- Recent Contacts enhancements
 - Do not add cc or bcc recipients to Recent Contacts
 - Better management of name/email address changes in Recent Contacts
 - Ability to block/remove email addresses from Recent Contacts that match a pattern



Other Notes User-focused features

- Go to different folder/view but keep the same message selected
 - Hold down the Ctrl key, and click the folder/view you want to open
- No interruptions during server failover
 - Creating a new e-mail, calendar entry, or to do item
 - Opening a document or a different folder/view in an application
 - Replying or forwarding with attachments
 - Sending a message
 - Deleting single or multiple documents
- Replication/synchronization is multi-threaded
- Lotus Connections integration – invite to network

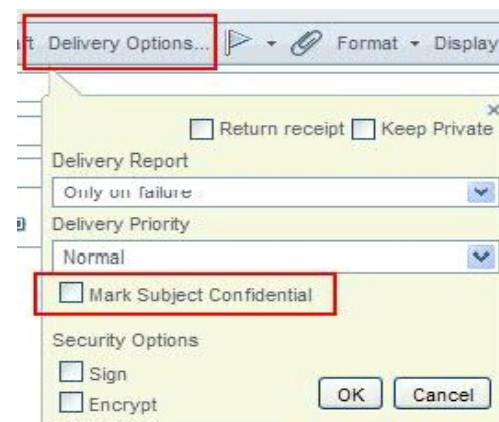
Lotus iNotes 8.5.2 – Mail

- Updated new message forms
 - New message, reply to and forward forms updated to reflect new Ajax UI
 - Asterisk appears in message tab to show that form is active and tab title updates to reflect message subject (in real time)
 - Updated inline spell check bar now available for full mode as well as for lite
 - Configuration setting to prevent creation of new message when users are over quota limits
 - Performance improved to save you time
 - Improved insert image dialog
- Mark subject confidential
 - New Delivery Options feature



Check out the cool new spell check bar in iNotes 8.5.2 full mode. It was originally available in 8.5.1 lite mode.

If I were typing a **message** and I messed up my spelling and wanted to check it just press the check button and the new spell check bar will appear.

- ****** Improved sorting on Subject ignoring specific keyword list, default includes Re: and Fw:
- Improve search by sender/subject
 - Provides a new option to search by sender or subject when right clicked on email.
- ****** Added a remove signature option and improved the signature UI
- ****** Indicates change to existing default behavior

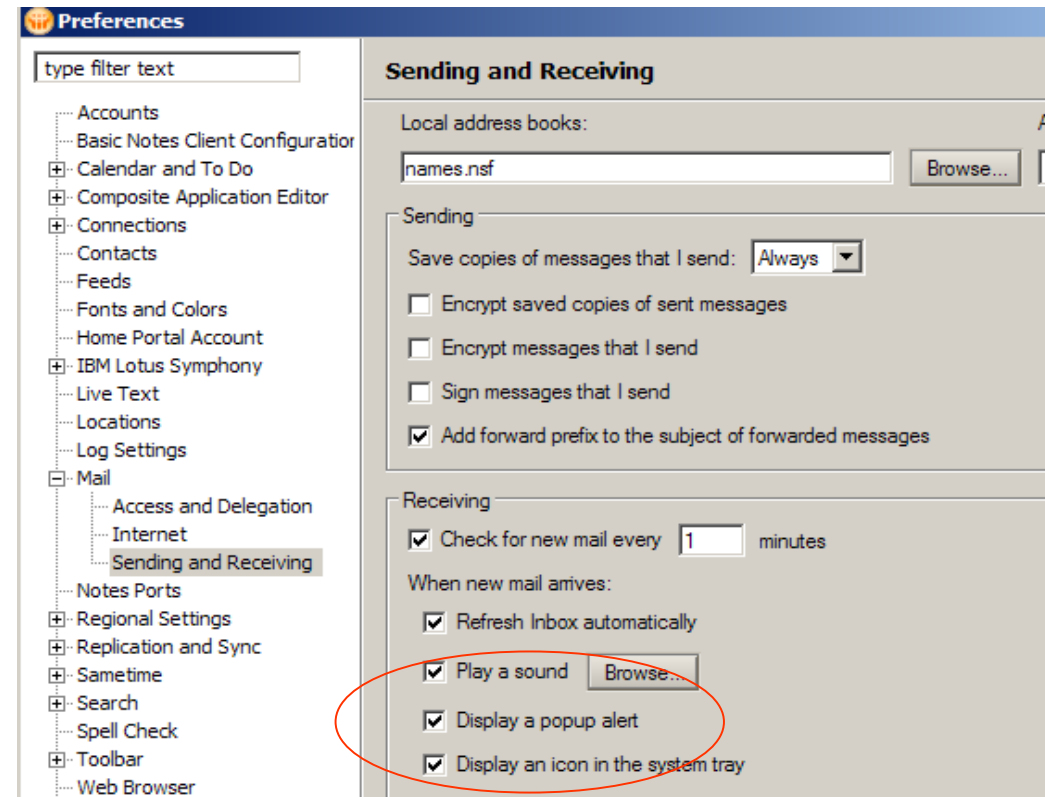
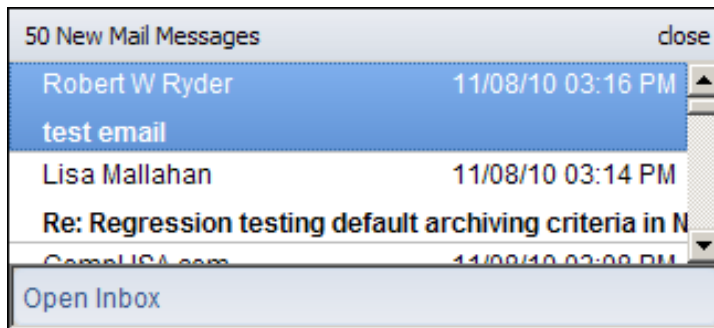

What's Planned for the Notes Client Near Term?

Notes Mail Improvements

- Enhanced new mail notification which displays subject and allows contents to be opened
 - New mail hover selectable using preference
 - Upon receiving new mail pop up displays in the lower right hand corner
 - Can pin display by grabbing and dragging



What's Planned for the Notes Client Near Term?

Notes Contact & Calendar Improvements

Notes Contacts Improvements :

- Additional controls included for populating Recent Contacts

Choose how names are added to Recent Contacts

- Do not add any names
- Add the following names:
 - All names
 - Only sender's name from emails I receive
 - Only the 'To' recipient names from emails I send & receive
 - Only names from e-mails I send

Notes Calendar Improvements:

- Adminp improvements for calendar documents around user renames
 - User renames are performed in everyones mail file
 - No longer just in the renamed users mail file
 - Not limited to “mail files”, will work for custom applications
 - User renames occur in several areas: Database ACL, Calendar Profiles, Color Coding Profiles & all C&S documents
 - No longer relies on the “Modify all Names fields” advanced ACL setting
 - Process all databases with “HAS_CALENDAR” set



What's Planned for the Notes Client Near Term?

Notes Calendar Improvements

** Planned Counterproposal Improvements

- Provide an option to leave the countered meeting on your calendar
- The default for the option to leave a countered meeting on your calendar is preference and/or policy controlled.

Countered meetings show:

- At the time the meeting was scheduled for
- As a unique color
- With hover text indicating the new proposed time
- With all invitee actions still available, in case invitee wants to modify response

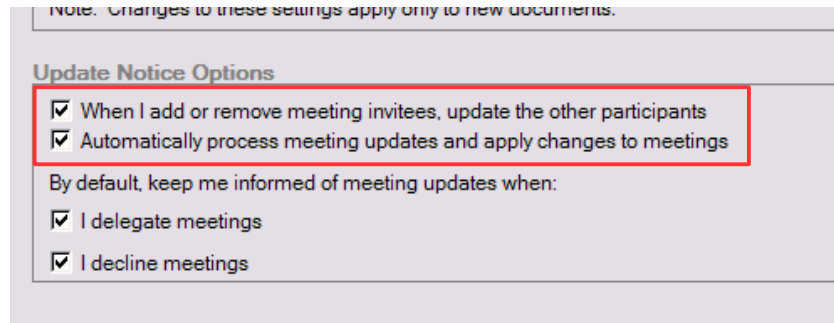

What's Planned for the Notes Client Near Term?

Notes Calendar Improvements

- Invitee list updates and autoprocessing enhancements
- Preferences/policies now exist to turn on invitee list updates and autoprocessing information updates



- Updates can be sent to all invitees when invitees are added or removed
 - This would behave just as any other informational field on a meeting
 - To maintain data, this results in multiple updates being sent for some repeating cases
- Once a meeting has been accepted, any non-time changes can automatically be applied on arrival
 - Removes the need to select 'Update Calendar' from the inbox or open the meeting to update it
 - Does not apply to meetings that are not yet accepted when update arrives
 - Does not apply to reschedules which must be accepted/declined and not be autoprocessed
 - Alleviates the user experience of multiple updates sent when invitees differ across a repeat meeting



What's Planned for the Notes Client Near Term?

LotusLive Notes Improvements

Enhancements in support of LotusLive Notes :

- Improvements to Client-Server transactions & better network toleration which includes an analysis of current transactions and reduction, or combination, where possible to improve network latency issues that the user might experience
- Selective policy enforcement based on machine
 - Ability to target specific policy settings at specific machine configurations allowing different settings based on machine or environmental characteristics

Single Sign-On Improvements :

- Provides SSO support for Standard Notes Client components like Connections, Sametime, etc
 - Includes any 3rd party plug-in application by leveraging Integrated SPNEGO authentication on Windows clients via Kerberos or NTLM



What's Planned for the Notes Client Near Term?

Notes Quality Improvements

Continued solidification of 8.5.x functionality

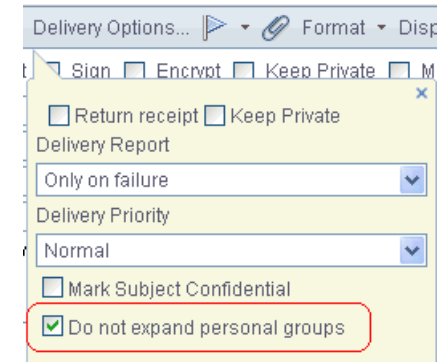
- Mac usability improvements for e-mail gestures: Drag one or grouped files to the Notes icon on your dock and a new mail message will be created with those files attached
- Connections business card improvements
- Geographic and time zone information will be displayed in the business card
- Support for some Sametime Standalone plugin_customization.ini settings that allow configuration of the business card
- Additional OS Support
 - RHEL 6.0 Desktop , Citrix XenApp 6.0, and enhanced 64-bit toleration for Windows
- Embedded component version upgrades to be available “in-the-box” for Notes
 - Sametime 8.5.1 (previously included 8.0.2 version)
 - Symphony 3.0 (previously included 1.3 version)

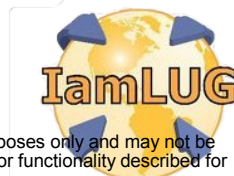
